HOW TO CHECK FOR A GAS LEAK

- ✓ Locate your properties gas meter and turn it o at the valve clockwise (Remember..lefty loosey / righty tighty!!)
- ✓ Carefully watch the dials or digital display on your meter and track any changes
- ✓ If the dial or display is still moving or increasing in value, then you have go a gas leak somewhere within your property
- ✓ If your leak is before the gas meter then you need to call AGL
- ✓ However for all leaks after the gas meter...call us!

DID YOU KNOW

POTENTIAL RISKS

If ventilation for any gas appliance becomes obstructed, then this can lead to extremely poisonous fumes such as carbon monoxide to be forced back into the room. This therefore contaminates the air that you, and those around you breathe in.

As carbon monoxide is colourless, odourless & tasteless, you will be unaware of its presence.
