# WATER LEAKS



## HOW TO CHECK FOR WATER LEAKS

1. Turn on all tap ware
2. Turn on all appliances, including all washing machines and dishwashers within the property.
3. DO NOT turn off the stop clock (remember the rule righty tighty; lefty loosy)
4. Check to see if the last dial is spinning on your water meter - If it is you have a water leak.
5. Call a fully licensed plumber to come and source the leak and resolve the problem.

### Q. HOW WILL YOU FIND MY LEAK?

A. Our highly trained plumbers are experts in detecting the source of leaks and creating the best solution to ensure that the problem doesn't reoccur. Sydney Water (as quoted from their site) add Chlorine, Ammonia, sodium hydroxide, sulphuric acid and other chemicals in order to filter and clean your water supply.
